Sporting Record

Andrew first represented Australia at the World Championships at Lexington in 1978 with DAVEY where they were eliminated. They came back to win Burghley in 1979 and came 15th at the Los Angeles Olympics in 1984. At Seoul in 1988 Andrew was 9th on KIWI and in 1992 was a member of the Gold medal team and 5th individually. DARIEN POWERS was one of only two horses to finish on their dressage score at the Open Europeans in 1995 to finish 12th. Horse and rider were in the Gold medal team at Atlanta. Andrew was also 11th in the individual competition with GERSHWIN. Team Gold medallist for the third consecutive Games at Sydney with Darien Powers and also Individual Silver medallist with SWIZZLE IN. 4TH at Burghley 2002 with MR PRACATAN and won Luhmuhlen 2002 with MOON FLEET. 9th at Burghley 2003 with MASTER MONARCH. 6th at Burghley 2005 with Mr Pracatan.

Badminton Record

Won in 2006 with MOON FLEET. In 1979 Andrew and Davey were eliminated on the crosscountry and they retired on that phase the following year. This Gold medallist completed for the first time in 1996 when he was 10th on Darien Powers. 9th in 2000 with Darien Powers, even with a stop XC. 8th in 2002 with Darien Powers. 7th in 2003 with MR PRACATAN. The pair came 5th in 2004 and 6th in 2005.

Andrew has been both a farmer and a rider and is based at Gatcombe Park. He is now married to German International Bettina (Overesch).
