Sporting Record

Probably the busiest event rider in the world, Andrew has achieved success without sponsorship. He completed the event at the L.A.Olympics in 1984 - KAHLUA and won a team Gold at the Stockholm World Games riding SPINNING RHOMBUS owned by Britain's top equestrian fund raiser Rosemary Barlow. The same horse flattened enough fences in the Show Jumping phase in Barcelona to lose New Zealand the team Gold medal. A consistent rider at top level Andrew won his first 'major' at Burghley in 1995 on the former Lynne Bevan ride BUCKLEY PROVINCE. With JAGERMEISTER Andrew was part of the Bronze team in Atlanta. Andrew was 5th at the 1998 World Games on NEW YORK. With Mr Smiffy he won at Burghley in 2000 and was 2nd in 2001. Was 9th at WEG 2002 with FENICIO and won the British Open Championships at Gatcombe 2002 with MALLARD'S TREAT. 3rd at Burghley 2003 with LORD KILLINGHURST. 7th at Blenheim 2003 with FLUSH BANKER. The pair finished 3rd at Burghley in 2005. 23rd at WEG 2006 with Lord Killinghurst. 13th at Burghley with HENRY TANKERVILLE and the pair won Bramham. 4th at Burghley on Lord Killinghurst in 2007.

Badminton Record

22nd in 1984 on Kahlua and 33rd the same year on RUBIN. Completed on MALIBU in 1985. Andrew retired on SCORPION in 1989, completed with SCHIROUBLES in 1990 and Spinning Rhombus in 1991 (retiring Schiroubles). Spinning Rhombus was 12th in 1993; 13th in 1995 with JAGERMEISTER II, Andrew retired Spinning Rhombus on the course. In 1996 Andrew was 8th with Buckley Province and 12th with Cartoon II. Andrew was 32nd in 1997 with Cartoon II. In 1998 Andrew was 14th on Cartoon and fell with Jagermeister II, but completed. He was 5th in 1999 on New York and 11th on Merillion that year. 7th with New York and 8th with Mr Smiffy in 2002. 11th in 2003 with FENICIO. He finished 2nd in 2004 with Lord Killinghurst, and 21st with Flush Banker. In 2005 Andrew finished 4th with Lord Killinghurst. 5th on Lord Killinghurst in 2007.

Personal

Andrew now tops the number of Badminton completions at 26, having overtaken Lorna Clarke's long standing record in 2005.
